2023 Annual Report

In 2023, the Center celebrated **20 years** of hope and healing for child victims of abuse and their families. We are grateful for the support of the community, our multidisciplinary team, our donors and funders, and everyone who has helped the Center grow and develop over the past 20 years! The Madison County CAC is committed to ensuring child victims of abuse are **heard**, **supported** and **connected**.

Forensic Interviews

465 children were provided a forensic interview and spoke to a trained professional about the abuse they may have experienced in a child focused environment.



Case Management

2026 children and family members were provided with information and support to navigate a child abuse investigation. Case Managers also provided connections to community resources and education to support children and keep them safe.



Therapy Services

272 children and their family members received specialized mental health services to help them heal from trauma and restore hope into their daily lives.



Prevention Education

5632 students received child sexual abuse prevention education to empower them with knowledge to keep themselves safe and create a safety network.



Community Connections

- 48 children received backpacks filled with school supplies for returning to school.
- 47 families received laundry baskets filled with food items and toys during the holiday season.
